


How to Solve the GoDaddy Error When Launching EPIC

For MAC.

1. Download the file **gdig2.crt.zip**

2. Extract the file to **gdig2.crt.zip**

1. Open Keychain Access

- Press Command + Space
- Type 'Keychain Access'
- Press Enter

2. Select the System Keychain

- Click 'System' on the left panel
- Click 'Certificates' at the top (optional)

3. Import the **gdig2.crt.pem** File

- Go to File → Import Items...
- Select **gdig2.crt.pem**
- Click Open


4. Set Trust Level (If Required)

- Double-click the certificate
- Expand 'Trust.'
- Set 'When using this certificate' to 'Always Trust.'
- Enter your admin password

5. Restart Browser or Application

- Restart Safari, Chrome, or Firefox
- Or restart the application using the certificate

You can check whether the certificate is correctly installed by opening Keychain Access in your Mac utilities folder (cmd+shift+U). Highlight "System," then select Certificates.
